

**ATTENTION: HIGH BRIDGE RESIDENT PARENTS OF PRESCHOOL AGE CHILDREN
DECEMBER 2018 LOTTERY – AFTERNOON SESSION OPENINGS ONLY**

High Bridge School District is offering a half-day preschool program for ages 3 and 4 for the second half of 2018-2019 school year, January 2019 thru June 2019. The program integrates 3- and 4-year-old students with diverse capabilities, five days a week, for three hours per day. There will be no school one Friday per month due to teacher collaboration. We are limiting this lottery to four openings in our afternoon session (12:10 to 3:10 pm) only. The program will be instructed by a teacher certified in both general and special education. The class will be supported by a paraprofessional, and the program will follow a state required curriculum. To be eligible your child must have turned 3 (or 4) by October 1, 2018.

This special lottery drawing will be held on Thursday, December 6, 2018, at 3:30 p.m. in the High Bridge Elementary School. Siblings are not guaranteed a space; each child's name must be selected.

This completed application must be returned **in person** with your child's **original, raised seal birth certificate** (which will be returned to you) and proof of residency (copy of your NJ driver's license is preferred, a copy of a current utility bill is an acceptable alternative). Applications will be accepted at the main office of either High Bridge Elementary or Middle School between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. **Deadline to accepting applications is by 2:00 pm on December 5, 2018.**

There is a nominal fee associated with the program of \$240 per month. Should your child be selected, the District will bill you in 6 equal installments. Tuition for January will be due December 17. Subsequent payments will be due on the 1st day of the preceding tuition month (i.e. February's payment will be due January 1, March's payment will be due February 1).

Tuition may be waived or reduced by 50% for eligible low income families. Low income qualification will be determined using the same guidelines as the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program. If you believe you qualify, please contact our Elementary School Nurse, Mrs. Nicole Cahill, for information at 908-638-4105, ext. 4218.

Please Note: All school registration requirements must be met, you must provide transportation to and from the program, and your child must be completely toilet trained prior to entrance into the program. The district may use its discretion in terminating program attendance of any child who is not completely toilet trained.
