0155 BOARD COMMITTEES

The Board of Education authorizes the creation of committees of Board members charged to conduct studies, make recommendations to the Board, and act in an advisory capacity. Committees are not authorized to take action on behalf of the Board.

The President shall appoint Board members t Board approved standing committees who will serve for a term not to exceed one year.

An ad hoc committee may be created and charged at any time by the President or a majority of the Board members present and voting. The President shall appoint members to any committee so created and charged; members shall serve until the committee is discharged.

Committees shall consist of no more than four (4) Board members, one of whom shall be the President, who shall serve as ex officio member on all Board committees. A member may request or refuse appointment to a committee; a member's refusal to serve on any one committee shall not prejudice his/her appointment to another committee.

A chairperson shall be appointed by the President.

Committee meetings shall be held when requested by the committee chairperson at a public meeting or charged to meet by the Board at a public meeting. Committee meetings, when feasible and appropriate shall be advertised and conducted as public meetings.
