

About the Hunterdon Strong Community Challenge



The Hunterdon Strong Community Challenge is one in which the 26 municipalities within Hunterdon County challenge each other to raise money in support of the community. The money raised will be distributed equally among 12 nonprofits within the county. Eleven of these nonprofits are members of the Partnership for Health. The only nonprofit included that is not a member of the Partnership for Health is the Hunterdon County First Responders. The participating organizations are:

The competition will kick off on Wednesday, September 23, 2020 and finish on Friday, November 13, 2020. People will make donations on a website that has been created specifically for this event. When making a donation, all donors will need to click on the drop-down menu to choose their municipality. This is how we will track the winning municipalities. There will be two first place prizes of \$2,000 each, and two second place prizes of \$500 each, that the municipalities will be competing for. The two categories for the competition are:

1. The municipality with the most money raised per capita
2. The municipality with the most participation per capita

The prize money will be donated to the schools within the winning municipalities.

Winners will be announced on the Hunterdon Strong Telethon on Thursday, November 19, 2020.
